4. Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?

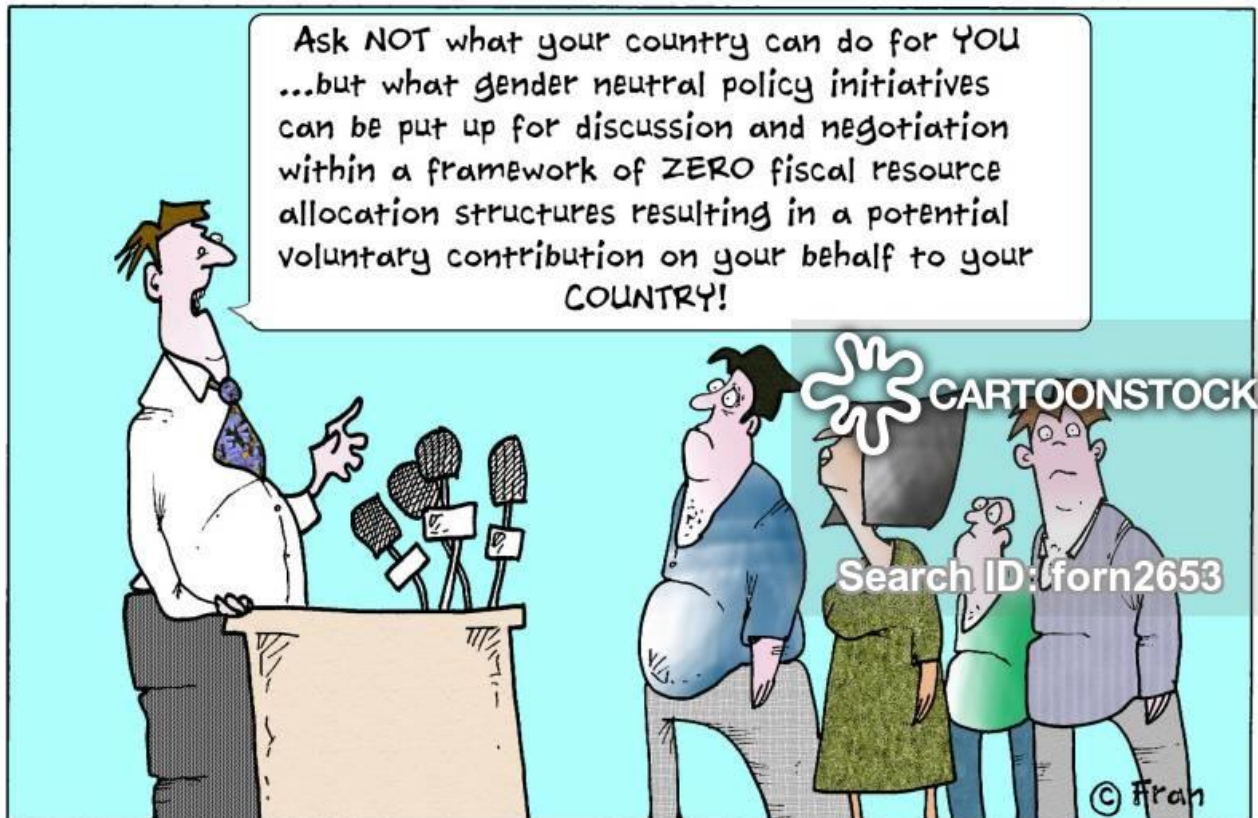

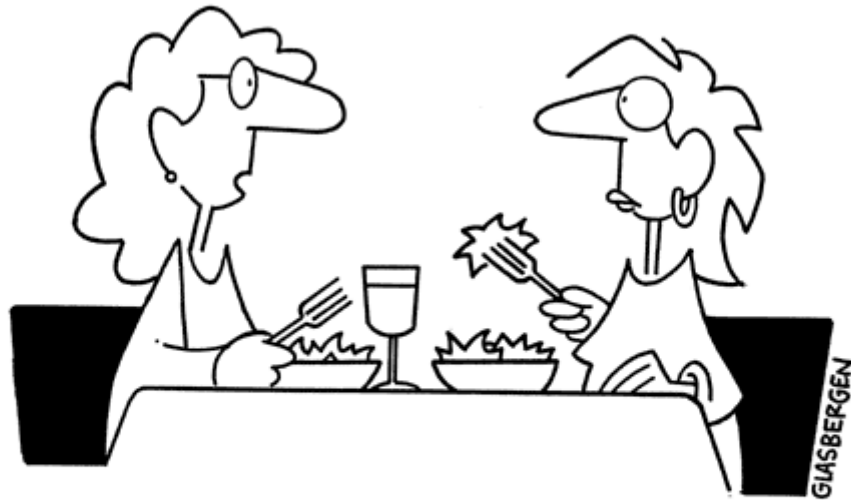
